| The child | • COVID-19 positive | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stop go to nursery • Consult public health care center and Ome city parenting promotion division • Close the nursery • Create a contact person list in the nursery • Disinfect the facility (Follow the instructions from the public health center) | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Permission of public health care center • Permission of the doctor |
| Family of the child | A family living together has symptoms <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fever (more than 37.5°C) • Cold • diarrhea • Dullness | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cured at home • Isolation at home (Infection prevention) | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No symptoms for the family and the child • End of self-restraint period of the family living together |
| Family of the child | A family living together determined to be a density contact person | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cured at home • Consult public health care center • 2 weeks health observation as a density contact person • Isolation at home (Infection prevention) | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No symptoms for the family and the child • End of self-restraint period of the family living together |
